## MINISTRY OF WELFARE RESOLUTION

New Delhi, the 9th March, 1996

1. S. O. No. 12011/96/94. BCC, - The Government of India, vide the ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension (Department of Personnel and Training) O. M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT), dated the 8th September, 1993, have reserved 27 percent of vacancies in civil posts and services under the Central Government, to be filled through direct recruitment, in favour of the Other Backward Classes (OBCs). This O.M. also specifies that OBCs for the purpose of the aforesaid reservation would comprise, in the first phase, the caste/communities which are common to both the lists in the Report of the Mandal Commission and the State Government's list of OBCs.
2. The common lists of OBCs in respect of 14 States, namely, Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh, in the context of implementation of the aforesaid O.M., were notified in the Ministry of Welfare Resolution No. 12011/68/93-BCC(C) dated the 10th September, 1993 and published in the Gazette of India-Extraordinary-Part I, Section 1 No. 186, New Delhi, Monday September 13, 1993/Bhadra 22, 1915.
3. Subsequently, the common lists of OBCs in respect of 4 States and 3 Union Territories, namely Orissa, Rajasthan, Tripura, West Bengal, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu and Pondicherry were notified in the Ministry of Welfare Resolution No. 12011/9/94-BCC dated the 19th October, 1994 and published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary, - Part I Section No. 163, New Delhi, Thursday October 20, 1994/Asvina 28, 1916.
4. Subsequently, the common lists of OBCs in respect of States of Jammu and Kashmir, Manipur and Sikkim and the NCT of Delhi were notified in the Ministry of Welfare's Resolution No. 12011/7/95-BCC dated the 24th May, 1995 and published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part-1, Section 1, No. 88, Thursday, May 25, 1995/Jyaishtha 4, 1917.

5. The National Commission for Backward Classes was set up under the provision of the National Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1993 to entertain, examine and recommend upon the requests for inclusion and complaints of over-inclusion and under-inclusion in the Central Lists of Other Backward Classes Act, 1993 to entertain, examine and recommend upon the requests for inclusion and complaints of over-inclusion and under-inclusion in the Central Lists of Other Backward Classes. The advice tendered by the Commission shall ordinarily be binding upon the Central Government.
6. The National Commission for Backward Classes have recommended names of castes/communities (including sub-castes/synonyms) for addition/inclusion/modification in the Central Lists of OBCs in respect of the following States:
  1. Andhra Pradesh
  2. Kerala
  3. Madhya Pradesh
  4. Maharashtra
  5. Orissa
  6. Tamil Nadu
  7. Tripura
  8. Uttar Pradesh
  9. West Bengal.

The Government have accepted the recommendations of the Commission and have decided to notify annexed additions/inclusions/modifications in the Central Lists of OBCs in respect of aforesaid States. These additions/inclusions/modifications shall take effect from the date of issue of this resolution.

ORDER :

In the G.O. Second read above orders have been issued changing the name of 'Kalavanthula' Caste included in the list of Backward Classes at Sl.No. 14 under Group 'D' in the G.O. 1st read above as 'Surya Balija' to wipe out the mental agony of the caste people and to end the social humiliation on them. In the G.O. first read above 'Kalavanthula and Ganika' Castes have been included as Backward Classes at Sl.No.14 under Group 'D'.

2. At the time of issue of G.O. Second read above the Andhra Pradesh Surya Balija Sangham has not requested for similar change of the Caste name in respect of 'Ganika'. In the representation third read above the Andhra Pradesh Suryabalija Sangham has requested the Government to change the name of the Caste 'Ganika' also as 'Surya Balija' since 'Ganika' is a Caste on par with Kalavanthula.

3. After careful consideration of the matter, Government have decided to change the nomenclature of 'Ganika' Caste at Sl.No. 14 under Group 'D' as Surya Balija. Government accordingly issue the following amendment to G.O.Ms.No. 1793, Education, dt.23.9.1970.

AMENDMENT

In supersession of the orders issued in the G:O.2nd read above the following amendment shall be inserted at Sl.No.14 under Group 'D' to Annexure-I to G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt:23.9.1970 and read as follows :-

"SL.NO.14 SURYA BALIJA (KALAVANTHULA, GANIKA.)"

Note : The names noted in the brackets are only for the purpose of identification. The Caste / Community Certificates are required to be issued as 'Surya Balija' only.

4. The Commissioner of Backward Classes Welfare shall take necessary action accordingly.

**ORDER :**

In the G.O. 1st read above, Government declared that the castes and communities specified in the Annexure-I to that G.O. are socially and educationally backward and classified them into four Groups as 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D'. The communities among other castes 'Kalavanthula', Ganika were included at Sl.No.14 under Group 'D' and at Sl.No.74 of the common list of Other Backward Classes in the Central list.

2. It has been represented by the Chairman, A.P.Surya Baliya Sangam to Government that the age old-Devadasi traditions were under exploitation in the name of temple services. With the prohibition of temple services in the early years of 1920, the people are termed as 'Kalavanthula' as they occupied in fine arts. But these people could not continue their occupations in fine arts and have engaged in other walks of life in different occupations like Tailors, Masons, employees, traders, agriculturists, farm labourers, Industrial workers etc. Though these people are thus carrying on in varied professions, the very caste name 'Kalavanthula' has been tempting the general public to recollect and recall the age old unsocial customs and conditions and the people particularly the working women and school going girls are put to mental agony on account of blemished social stigma in the name of 'Kalavanthula'. They have therefore requested the Government to change their caste name as 'Surya Baliya'.

3. After careful consideration of the matter, Government have decided to change the nomenclature of 'Kalavanthula' caste at Sl.No. 14 under Group 'D' as 'Surya Baliya' to wipe out the mental agony of the caste people and to end the social humiliation on them. They (Government) accordingly issue the following amendment to G.O.Ms.No. 1793, Education, dt.23.9.1970:-

The following shall be inserted as against at Sl.No.14 under Group 'D' to Annexure-I to G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.9.1970 and read as follows :-

AMENDMENT

In supersession of the orders issued in the G.O.2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the following amendment shall be inserted at Sl.No.14 under Group –D to Annexure-1 to G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education Dt.23-9-1970 and read as follows:

“SL.NO.14 SURYA BALIJA (KALAVANTHULA, GANIKA)”

Note: The names noted in the brackets are only for the purpose of identification. The caste/Community certificates are required to be issued as SURYA BALIJA only.

Hence, all the Tahsildars in the District are informed that **Kalavanthula and Ganika** are only for the purpose of identification and requested to issue **SURYA BALIJA (BC-D)** caste certificates only to all the Surya Baliya, Kalavanthula and Ganika caste people in the District.
